## VERIFIED PETITION FOR IMMEDIATE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

The Judicial Standards Commission of the State of New Mexico ("Petitioner"), through the undersigned counsel, hereby petitions under seal pursuant to Rule 27-104(B) NMRA the New Mexico Supreme Court for an order that immediately and temporarily suspends Respondent Hon. Jaime J. Baca from judicial office pending completion of the State's prosecution of the pending criminal complaint and Petitioner Judicial Standards Commission's proceedings. The Commission hereby requests,

pursuant to Rule 27-104(B) NMRA, that this Petition and all Responses thereto should be unsealed upon an Order of the Court. As grounds for this verified petition, Petitioner states:

- 1. Petitioner invokes its jurisdiction and files this *Verified Petition for Immediate Temporary Suspension* pursuant to Petitioner's power to recommend the discipline of judges and the Supreme Court's power to discipline judges under N.M. Const. art. VI, §32; the Supreme Court's power of superintending control under N.M. Const. art. VI, §3; Rule 27-201(A)(4)(a) and (b) NMRA 1996 of the Rules Governing Review of the Judicial Standards Commission Proceedings; and, Rule 32(A)(4)(a) and (b) NMRA 2010 of the Judicial Standards Commission Rules.
- 2. The Respondent, Hon. Jaime J. Baca, is the probate judge for Valencia County, New Mexico.
- 3. Respondent is alleged to have committed acts that may constitute willful misconduct in office. The alleged acts are set forth in the Commission's *Notice of Preliminary Investigation*. (See attached Exhibit A.)

Notice of Preliminary Investigation in Inquiry No. 2013-157.) The acts alleged are summarized as follows:

On December 21, 2013, New Mexico State Police officers Α. were dispatched to a private residence in Los Lunas in reference to a domestic dispute involving the Respondent Following a verbal argument with his girlfriend, judge. Respondent is alleged to have thrown his girlfriend to the ground, causing minor injuries; taken his girlfriend's cell phone away from her when she tried to call for help and thrown the phone into the street, where it was run over by a passing vehicle; and, thrown a rock through the window of his girlfriend's car, causing it to shatter. An arrest warrant was obtained and Respondent was arrested on December 22, 2013 for Battery Against a Household Member, Criminal Damage to Property (2 counts), and Interference with Communications. Respondent was arraigned on the above-listed charges on December 23, 2013. (See Exhibit B, Criminal Complaint, Affidavit

- for Arrest Warrant, and Arrest Warrant in State v. Jaime Baca, M-59-VM-2013-00108, for a detailed statement of the events.)
- 4. Petitioner is conducting an investigation into Respondent's conduct.
- 5. Petitioner requests that the Supreme Court issue an order that the Respondent be immediately and temporarily suspended. As such, this Court would control the time, terms, and conditions of Respondent's return to official duties.
- 6. Respondent's acts may constitute criminal conduct and willful misconduct in office as set forth in Article VI, §32 of the New Mexico Constitution.
- 7. Petitioner certifies that Respondent's immediate temporary suspension from judicial office is necessary pending resolution of the State's criminal prosecution and the Petitioner Judicial Standards Commission's proceedings. Petitioner's Certificate to this Supreme Court is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**. Petitioner defers to this Supreme Court as

to whether Respondent's temporary suspension shall be with or without pay.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays for an Order from the Court that immediately and temporarily suspends Respondent Hon. Jaime J. Baca from judicial office pending completion of the State's prosecution of the pending criminal complaint and Petitioner's proceedings.





On Saturday, December 21, 2013, at approximately 2338 hours, Affiant Officer Leroy O. Carrejo with the New Mexico State Police Uniform Division was in uniform, displaying my badge of office in my assigned unit 655, while working in Los Lunas, New Mexico County of Valencia Affiant was dispatched to the residence of reference a domestic dispute that occurred on State Road 47 near the intersection of Horner Road.

While responding dispatch notified me of the reporting persons stating that the male subject involved had left the scene on foot. Upon arrival I met with the alleged victim identified as Jeri Ortega who stated her boyfriend Jaime Baca had battered her. Ms. Ortega stated she then ran to the residence of The vehicle Ms. Ortega and Mr. Baca were in is registered to Ms. Ortega and a rock was thrown through the right rear window of the vehicle causing it to shatter with the rock going through and coming to rest on the floor board. The vehicle was photographed as well. The residence of belongs to Gary and Maxine Schmock who both stated Ms. Ortega showed with stickers all over her and observed the bruise and cut sustained. Mr. Schmock stated he went for the vehicle which was left on State Road 47 just south of Horner which was approximately .3 miles away. Ms. Ortega stated she had some soreness to her left mid section also but no bruising. Attempts to locate Mr. Baca were unsuccessful. Affiant went to the residence of where Mr. Baca resides and made contact with Mr. Baca's father but Mr. Baca was not present. 
