ORDER

WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon the Judicial Standards Commission's motion to accept stipulation agreement, the Court having considered the petition and being sufficiently advised, and having determined that acceptance of the stipulation is in the best interests of the judiciary and the public, Chief Justice Barbara J. Vigil, Justice Petra Jimenez Maes, Justice Richard C. Bosson, Justice Edward L. Chávez, and Justice Charles W. Daniels concurring;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition to accept stipulation agreement is GRANTED and the stipulation to permanent resignation upon expiration of the term of office is APPROVED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the permanent resignation of respondent, Magistrate Judge Rudy Martin, shall be effective at the expiration

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall never again hold, become a candidate for, run for, or stand for election to any New Mexico judicial office in the future;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall never seek, accept appointment to, or serve *pro tempore* for any New Mexico judicial office in the future, which includes the posts of judge in municipal court, probate court, magistrate court, metropolitan court, district court, Court of Appeals, and Justice of the Supreme Court;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall never again hold or exercise any judicial authority in the State of New Mexico; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all documents filed in this Court in Inquiry Nos. 2014-112, 2014-135, 2014-150 are UNSEALED pursuant to Rule 27-104(B) NMRA.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
