ORDER

WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon a verified petition for immediate temporary suspension filed by the Judicial Standards Commission and a stipulated joint request of the parties that Respondent should be temporarily suspended from judicial office without further hearing in this Court pending completion of the Judicial Standards Commission's proceedings, and the Court having considered the petition and joint stipulation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Charles W. Daniels, Justice Patricio M. Serna, Justice Petra Jimenez Maes, Justice Richard C. Bosson, and Justice Edward L. Chávez concurring;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT the stipulation of the parties is approved and that Victoria J. Grant hereby is TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED from judicial office, effective at 5:00 p.m. on this day of

1 April 30, 2010 until further order of this Court; and that unless this Court
2 subsequently orders otherwise, the suspension shall be with pay for no
3 longer than ninety days; and

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the oral argument previously
5 scheduled for May 4, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. is hereby vacated.
