IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within six (6) weeks of the date of this order, respondent shall review the 40-hour videotaped New Municipal Judges Orientation program provided by the Judicial Education Center and, upon completion, shall promptly submit written certification that she has done so to this Court and the Commission;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall promptly comply with the requirements set forth in Section 9 of the Stipulation Agreement and Consent

to Discipline to obtain and implement the required training and written policies, procedures, and checklists for the court clerks in respondent's court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the file is UNSEALED in accordance with Rule 27-104(B) NMRA.
