9                                   **ORDER**

10           WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon petition  
11 of the Judicial Standards Commission to accept the stipulation agreement and  
12 consent to discipline, motion to supplement the petition with a stipulated proposed  
13 public censure, and the oral arguments of the parties on July 12, 2022, and the Court  
14 having considered the foregoing and being sufficiently advised; Chief Justice C.  
15 Shannon Bacon, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Julie  
16 J. Vargas, and Briana H. Zamora concurring;

17           NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition is GRANTED in part  
18 and DENIED in part, to the extent that this Court does not accept the stipulated  
19 public censure as proposed, pursuant to Rule 27-401(A) NMRA;

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the requirement set forth in the petition that  
2 Judge Mary W. Rosner complete the judicial education course, Ethics and Judging:  
3 Reaching Higher Ground, by July 30, 2022, has been satisfied;

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court shall issue its own public censure,  
5 which will be issued separately and published in accordance with Rule 17-206(D)  
6 NMRA; and

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the documents filed in this matter shall be  
8 unsealed pursuant to Rule 27-104(B) NMRA.

9 IT IS SO ORDERED.
